ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS
CONTRACT P-2011-1**

Notice is hereby given that sealed proposals for Contract P-2011-1, Construction of Handicapped Ramps, will be received by the Borough of Palmyra, Burlington County, New Jersey, **at 10:30 a.m., prevailing time on September 7, 2011** in the Municipal Building, 20 W. Broad Street, Palmyra, New Jersey, at which time and place the bids will be publicly opened and read aloud. The work under Contract P-2011-1 consists of furnishing all equipment, labor and materials for the removal and replacement of existing handicapped ramps or the installation of new handicapped ramps in compliance with ADA standards at various locations within the Borough, including the installation or reconstruction of concrete curb, ramp and sidewalk areas, replacement of flat pavers with truncated dome pavers, installation of new handicapped ramps with truncated dome tiles, replacement of existing inlet heads with appropriate curb pieces and bicycle safe grates, reconstruction of existing inlets and restoration of disturbed areas.

Bids must be prepared on the standard proposal form, in the manner designated therein, and must be enclosed in a sealed envelope using the name and address of the bidder and name of the proposed work on the outside, addressed to the Palmyra Borough Clerk, 20 W. Broad Street, Palmyra, NJ 08065, and must be accompanied by a proposal bond or certified check for the sum of not less than 10% of the amount bid provided said proposal bond or check amount need not be more than \$20,000.00 nor less than \$500.00.

The successful bidder will be required to furnish a satisfactory Performance Bond in the sum of the full amount of the contract.

All proposals submitted by corporations or partnerships shall list names of stock-holders in accordance with P.L. 1977, C.33. Bidders are required to comply with the requirements of P.L. 1975, C.127 and N.J.S.A 10:5-31 et seq. which are acts and regulations relating to affirmative action discrimination in connection with certain public contracts and; and shall pay prevailing wage rates in accordance with P.L. 1963, C.150.

The Borough of Palmyra reserves the right to reject any or all bids and to waive any insignificant defect or informality in any bid should it be in the interest of the Borough to do so.
