

**THE BOROUGH OF PALMYRA
ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS
CONTRACT P-2011-2**

Notice is hereby given that sealed proposals for Contract P-2011-2, South Broad Street Overlay, will be received by the Borough of Palmyra, Burlington County, New Jersey, **at 10:30 a.m., prevailing time on September 9, 2011** in the Municipal Building, 20 W. Broad Street, Palmyra, New Jersey, at which time and place the bids will be publicly opened and read aloud. In general, the work under Contract P-2011-2 consists of furnishing all equipment, labor and materials for the asphalt overlay of South Broad Street between Cinnaminson Avenue and Chestnut Street.

Approximate quantities of the major work items to be included in the Contract are as follows:

All checks are to be made payable to Land Engineering & Surveying Company, Inc. An additional \$20.00 postage and handling fee will be charged for each set of documents to be mailed.

Bids must be prepared on the standard proposal form, in the manner designated therein, and must be enclosed in a sealed envelope using the name and address of the bidder and name of the proposed work on the outside, addressed to the Palmyra Borough Clerk, 20 W. Broad Street, Palmyra, NJ 08065, and must be accompanied by a proposal bond or certified check for the sum of not less than 10% of the amount bid provided said proposal bond or check amount need not be more than \$20,000.00 nor less than \$500.00.

The successful bidder will be required to furnish a satisfactory Performance Bond in the sum of the full amount of the contract.

All proposals submitted by corporations or partnerships shall list names of stock-holders in accordance with P.L. 1977, C.33. Bidders are required to comply with the requirements of P.L. 1975, C.127 which is an act relating to affirmative action in relation to discrimination in connection with certain public contracts; and, shall pay prevailing wage rates in accordance with P.L. 1963, C.150.

The Borough of Palmyra reserves the right to reject any or all bids and to waive any insignificant defect or informality in any bid should it be in the interest of the Borough to do so.
